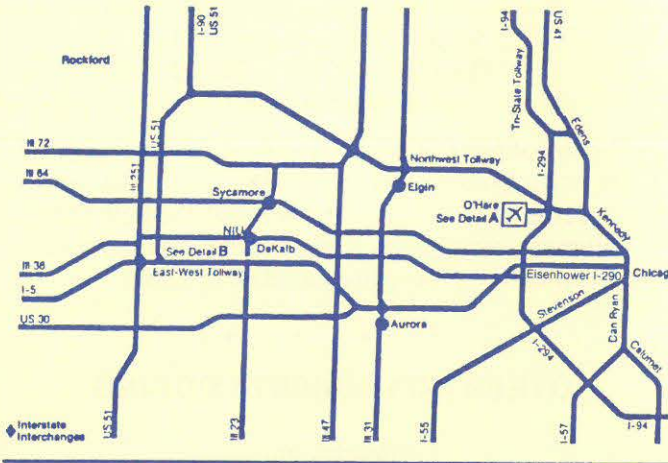

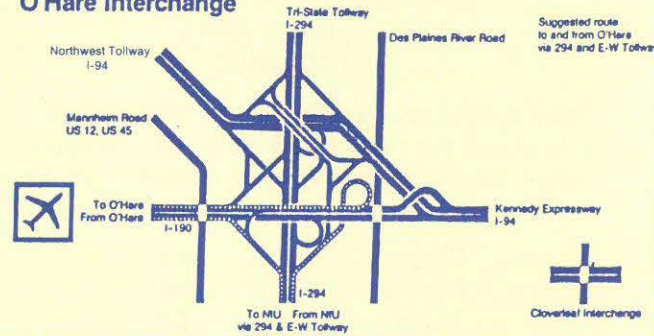

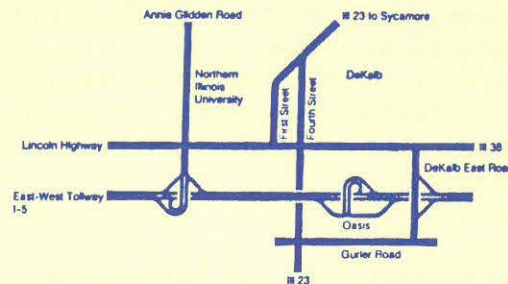
Northern Illinois Highways
