This discussion will examine the prospects for restarting Fulbright in China and Hong Kong. US Fulbright programs in China and Hong Kong were terminated in 2020 by the president. In contrast, DAAD student and scholar exchange programs with China and Hong Kong, programs sponsored by the German government that involve over 2000 students and scholars per year, have continued without interruption.
